Minimally Invasive Surgery at SIUT

SIUT model for free care has benefited hundreds of patients from all over Pakistan. To treat such large number of patients SIUT has been pioneering many cutting-edge advances in medical technology. Minimally invasive surgery (SIUT) is one of these. SIUT was the first to develop shockwave lithotripsy for stone treatment, percutaneous stone removal from kidney and bladder by key hole surgery in urology.

Laparoscopic surgery, a MIS technique involves using special scopes to look inside the body and then operating with advanced instruments through very small stab-incisions. This does away with the need to give big cuts otherwise required to gain access to abdomen or chest for surgery. The result is a much faster recovery after surgery, much less pain and much better cosmetic outcome for the patients. This technique has developed by leaps and bound over last two decades and is finding more and more applications in surgery with every passing day.

In Pakistan laparoscopic surgery has been slow in development. The limitations have been in terms of acquiring and maintaining the high-cost equipment and the demanding training required for developing the skills and expertise. SIUT has invested significantly on both accounts whereby the result is that today there are many trained teams of surgeons in this field. SIUT acknowledges the great contribution of our expatriates from UK who have helped in the training for laparoscopic surgery. 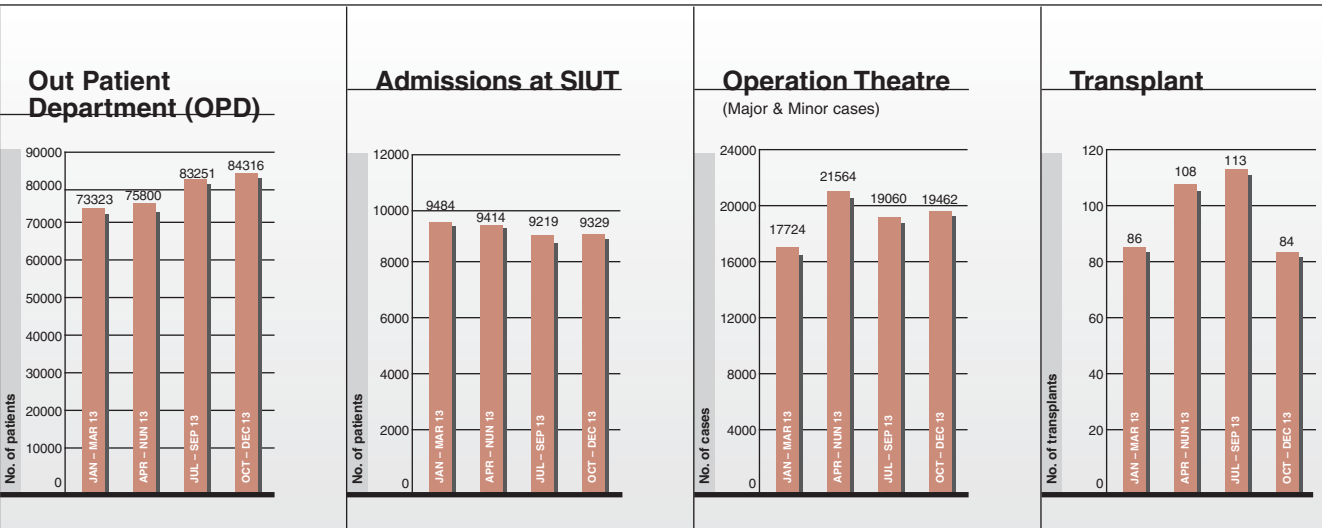

lifetime opportunity for quality professional education without charges. Candidates who have completed their academic and training are successfully providing quality health care to the patient in country and abroad



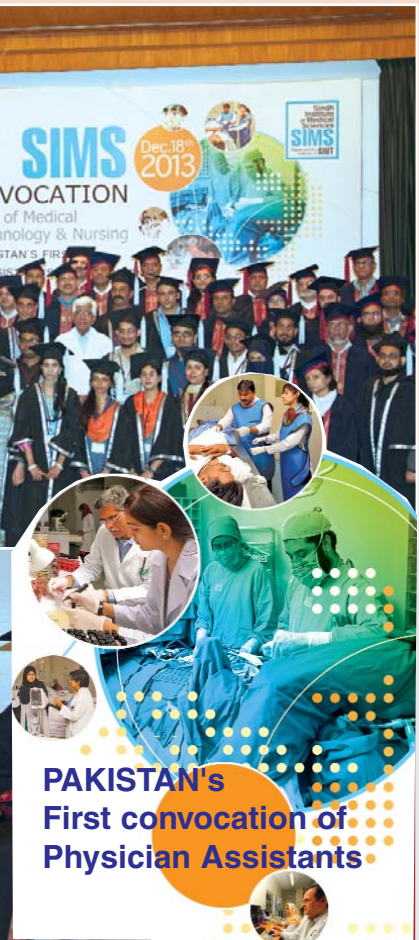
