Pakistan has the largest burden of hepatitis C worldwide with figures of 8.8 million affected individuals. Unsafe healthcare practices, injection therapy, unscreened blood transfusions, sharing of personal items have contributed to the rapid spread of the virus.

The importance of using new syringes at clinics, fresh razor blades at barber shops and sterilized equipment for dental and cosmetic procedures was highlighted. The experts who spoke on the occasion included Dr. Abbas Ali Tasneem, Dr. Mudassir Laeeg, Dr. Zain Majid, Dr. Nadir Sattar, Dr. Nida Rasool Maher and dietician Ms. Kehkashan Zehra.

Fire and Safety First Lecture by Chief Fire Officer, KPT


