# SIUT hosts the 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Asia Pacific Association of Paediatric Urologists (APAPU)


# Live Surgery Workshop and Conference

IUT in collaboration with APAPU organized the 23rd APAPU conference and a live surgery workshop from Nov 29 - 2nd December 2023. The main organizers of this event were Dr. Sajid Sultan (SIUT) President of the Conference, Mr. Philip G Ransley (UK), Dr. H. K. Dhillon (Singapore), Dr. Bashir Ahmed (SIUT) and Dr. Sadaf Aba Umer Kodwavwala (SIUT). The conference and workshop were attended by 375 delegates from abroad and Pakistan. Over 50 delegates from abroad included 24 invited speakers from across the globe including Afghanistan, China, Egypt, France, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Malaysia, Philippines, South Korea, Taiwan, Turkey, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom. The event included 2 days of live surgery workshops in three theaters and 2 days of scientific sessions. The workshop was conducted by renowned surgeons Mr. Philip G Ransley (UK), Gianantonio Manzoni (Italy), Prof. Alaa El Ghoneimi (France), Dr. Marc-David Leclair (France), Alfredo Berrettini (Italy), Dr. Mazen Zeino (Switzerland) and Dr. Chung-Kwong Yeung (Hong Kong).

In the inauguration ceremony, prominent citizen and supporter of SIUT, Mr. Hameed Haroon highlighted the role of SIUT in healthcare in Pakistan and the importance of awareness and prevention of healthcare problems in children.

The overseas Experts included Dr. Khurshid Guru from Roswell Park Cancer Center (USA), Dr. Mark Slack, Medical Director, CMR Surgical, Cambridge (UK), Dr.







Marcus Carey, Royal Women's Hospital (Australia) and Dr. Pritpal Singh (India). Local speakers included Prof. Shahid Rasul JPMC (Karachi), Dr. Noman Zafar PKLI (Lahore), Prof. Mahmoud Ayyaz, King Edward Medical University (Lahore) and Dr. Mohammad Arsalan Khan and Prof Rehan Mohsin from SIUT. These Experts highlighted the difference and clear advantages of the new technology as it allows work inside confirmed areas of human body with accuracy and precision. SIUT started robotic surgery in 2017 sharing a Robotic System with Civil Hospital. In November2021 SIUT installed its own Robotic System - Versius Robotic Surgical System. Since its commencement more than 1700 surgeries have been performed by SIUT. ■








## Guest Lecture by Prof. Azra Raza
