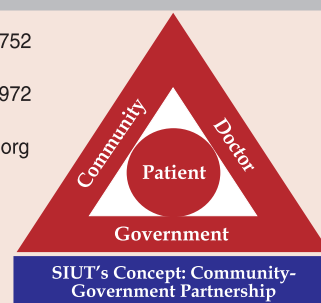

Breast Cancer Treatment at SIUT

Breast Cancer Awareness month was held at SIUT during October 2024. The incidence in Pakistan is one in every 9 women. SIUT is an institution that regards health is a birth right for all. Breast oncology clinic is held on every Mondays on the first floor of Hanifa Suleman Dawood Oncology building. It combines a clinic run in a joint approach with breast surgeons, medical, radiation oncologists and supportive radiologists. The services provided at the clinic are from checking a new patient to onsite breast ultrasounds, mammography and biopsies which cuts down the waiting period for diagnosis and treatment.

In the last 3 years SIUT has registered about 500 breast cancer patients majority of whom registered with us are between 30 – 50 years. Amongst these about just over a third present with a family history. Women now come not only for treatment but also to get advice for breast cancer screening. We are also now getting to see men with breast cancer that has an incidence of 1-3 percent worldwide. ■

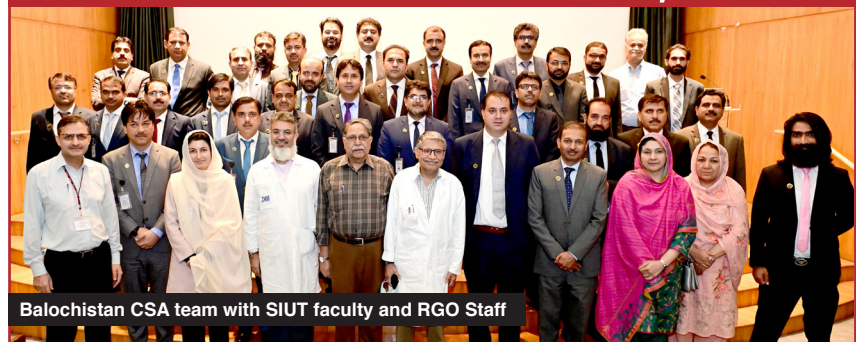
Fire Awareness Activity At SIUT

The topic was "The ever expanding horizons of medicine". ■



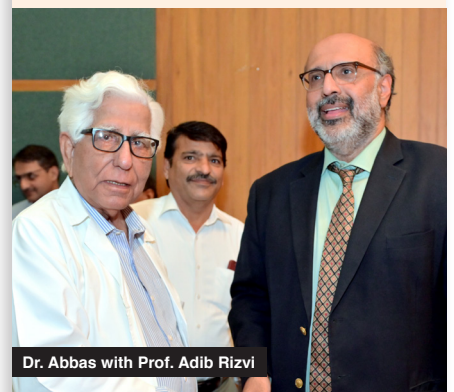

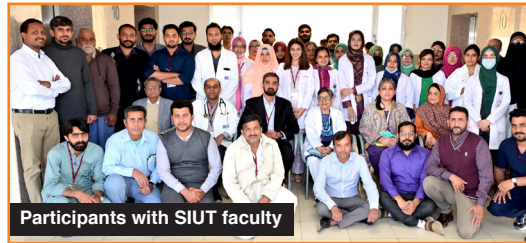

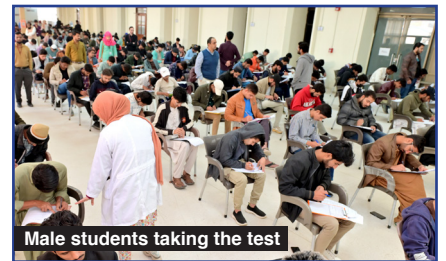
