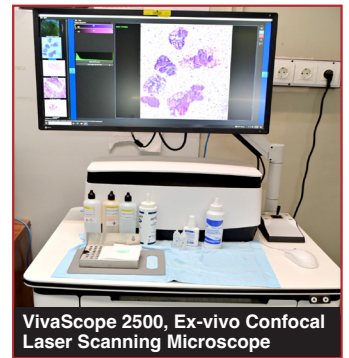


SIUT Philosophy — To remain at the cutting-edge of technology Transforming Pathology – SIUT acquires an advanced Ex-vivo Confocal Laser Scanning Microscope for routine histopathology

Since its inception in 1971, the 8-bedded urology ward and the then the Institute of Urology and Transplantation in 1991 have always strived to remain at the cutting edge of technology. There have been many firsts in Pakistan in both Surgery, Medicine, and allied departments. The pathology department has achieved many milestones. An Electron Microscopy lab, a DNA typing facility, and the latest addition has been of an advanced ex-vivo confocal laser scanning microscope designed to provide histological quality images of fresh tissue without the need for traditional processing such as fixation, embedding, and sectioning. Using dual laser technology, it simultaneously captures reflectance and fluorescence signals, which are digitally processed to generate pseudo-colored images resembling standard hematoxylin and eosin (H&E) staining. This allows pathologists to assess tissue morphology at a subcellular level within minutes, significantly reducing diagnostic turnaround time compared to conventional methods. The VivaScope 2500 is on State as Art Dual Laser Technology Machine.

The VivaScope 2500 offers several clinical advantages, including rapid on-site biopsy evaluation and improved intraoperative decision-making. It also preserves tissue for further histological and molecular studies while reducing reliance on frozen sections, enhancing efficiency and cost-effectiveness.

The second addition is the digital slide scanner in the Histopathology. This transition represents a significant step toward modernizing histopathology workflows, enabling whole-slide imaging (WSIs), remote reporting and consultation, and improved archival and retrieval of cases. The system allows glass slides to be converted into high-resolution digital images, facilitating accurate, efficient, and collaborative diagnosis.

Digital pathology at SIUT offers multiple advantages, including enhanced workflow efficiency, remote consultations, improved teaching capabilities, and opportunities for research and

artificial intelligence (AI) integration. This pioneering initiative reinforces SIUT's commitment to adopting cutting-edge technologies and sets the stage for broader implementation of digital pathology across Pakistan. ■

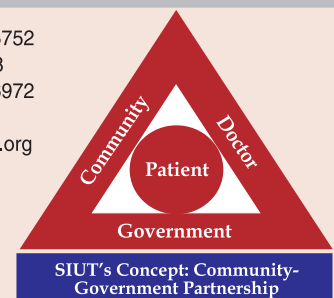

Advanced regional anesthesia techniques, including ultrasound-guided truncal blocks for surgery/postoperative pain management, through its Skills Lab and in conjunction with national conferences like IMECON 2026. These workshops focus on hands-on practice, covering blocks such as the transverses abdominis plane (TAP) and quadratus lumborum (QL and QL 2) block. Pectoralis nerve (PECS1 and PECS 2) Erector spinae plane block (ESP).

Patient safety is the symphony of healthcare when every action, every hand, and every heart works in harmony, guided by compassion and commitment, safety prevails above all. ■

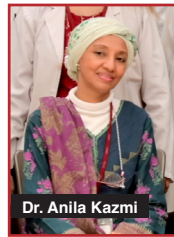

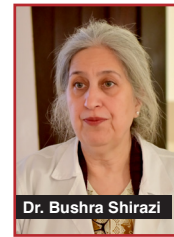

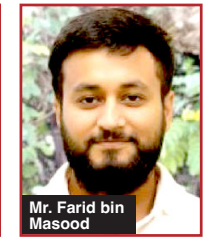
