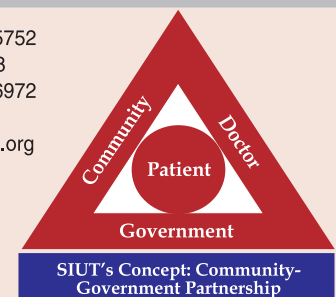

### SIUT celebrates Christmas

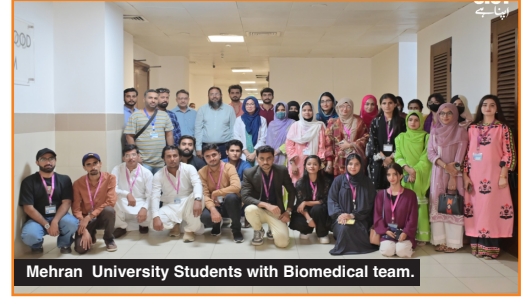

## SIUT's Team of Congenital Heart Diseases Experts Established Medical Camp in Najaf

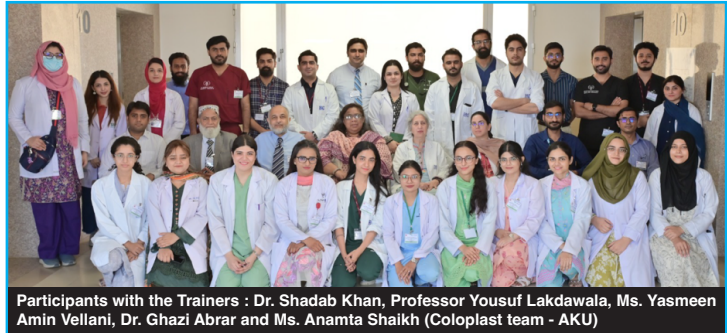

The Division of Cardiothoracic Sciences at SIUT hosted the first-of-its-kind workshop in Pakistan on Advances in Perfusion Technology – The Quantum Approach, in collaboration with Spectrum Medical on October 31, 2025

Over 40 cardiac perfusionists from Karachi and Hyderabad participated in this intensive, hands-on training introducing the Quantum Heart-Lung Machine (HLM), a state-of-the-art system designed for data-driven, physiology-based perfusion and enhanced patient safety.
