SIUT Successfully Performs Its First Endovascular Aortic Repair (EVAR)

SIUT achieved a significant milestone in vascular surgery by successfully performing its first Endovascular Aortic Repair (EVAR) on 14th May 2026 in the newly established Hybrid Theatre at the Maryam Bashir Dawood Children's Hospital. EVAR is a minimally invasive alternative to open aortic surgery that significantly reduces operative risk, blood loss, hospital stay, and recovery time, particularly for high-risk patients.

The procedure was performed on a 47-year-old-renal transplant patient diagnosed with a high-risk 8.1 cm infrarenal abdominal aortic aneurysm. The team successfully deployed a stent graft while preserving both the native and transplanted renal vessels, ensuring a favorable outcome.

This landmark procedure was led jointly by the Vascular Surgery teams of SIUT and the Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Institute of Trauma (SMBBIT), Karachi, with invaluable support from the SIUT

SIUT has always been at the forefront of acquiring cutting-edge technology. SIUT introduced the Advanced Thulium Laser Technique for the treatment of Benign Enlarged Prostate.

To support this initiative, SIUT is collaborating with internationally renowned urologist Prof. Mehmet ilker Gokce, MD, from Ankara University School of Medicine, Turkey. During his visit to Karachi, Prof. Gokce performed live surgical procedures and provided hands-on training to SIUT's urological surgery team in this state-of-the-art technique.

structures and nerves. An additional advantage is its ability to simultaneously seal blood vessels during tissue removal, resulting in minimal bleeding and enhanced safety—even for high-risk cardiac patients and those taking blood-thinning medications. ■

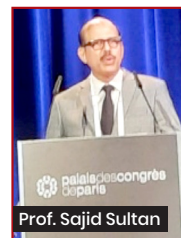

International Hyperoxaluria Workshop 2026

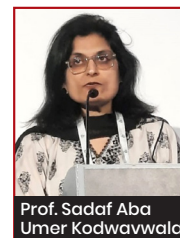

SIUT's Paediatric Urology Team attends 36th ESPU Congress in France

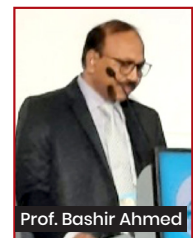

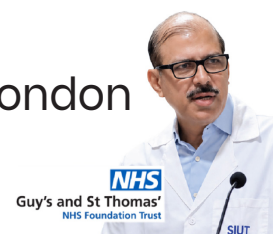

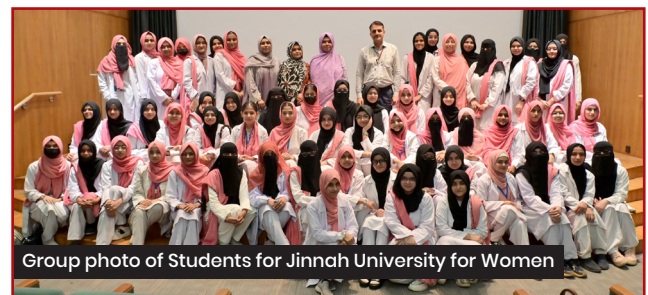
The students appreciated the State of Art medical services available at SIUT. ■

The delegation expressed their profound admiration for the hospital's services. Mr. Zahid Kamal from Bahria



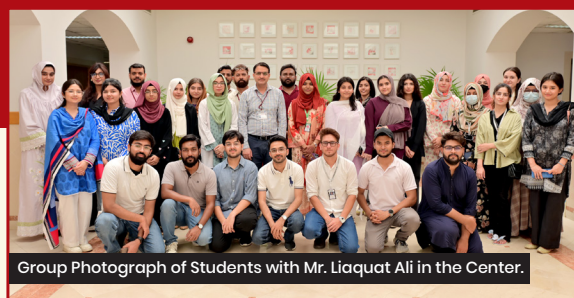

Safer Health Delivery – Safe Injection Practices

Infectious Diseases Dept. and Medical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases Society of Pakistan held a Workshop at SIUT Trust Hospital on 13th June 2026. Pakistan is facing a rapidly growing HIV epidemic, with a significant number of infections linked to unsafe medical practices. While global HIV infections continue to decline, Pakistan has witnessed a 200% rise in new cases over the past 15 years.

Dr. Asma Naseem, Dr. Sunil Dodani of SIUT and Dr. Samreen Sarfaraz of Indus Hospital highlighted the urgent need for safe injection practices, the use of auto-disable syringes, stronger public awareness, and healthcare worker education—particularly to protect children, who have been disproportionately affected in recent outbreaks. ■

World Obstetric Fistula Day 2026

SIUT observed World Obstetric Fistula Day on 23rd May 2026. Going forward, the vision is to end Fistula in Pakistan by the year 2030. The event highlighted the urgent need to improve national healthcare and to build safe motherhood and fistula-free communities. Every year, an estimated 4,000 to 5,000 women develop obstetric fistulas during child birth in Pakistan. Many women cannot reach hospitals on time because of long distances, lack of transport, and the non-availability of free ambulance services. Home deliveries conducted without skilled birth attendants further increase the risk. SIUT is one of the few centres providing free treatment with dignity through minimally invasive techniques. So far, more than a thousand fistula surgeries have been performed. The institute is running a dedicated fistula clinic every Friday. Preventing obstetric fistula is not merely a medical issue; it is a matter of women's rights, social justice and human dignity. ■

The Fundamentals of Critical Care Support (FCCS) workshop was held at SIUT for the third time, organized by the Department of Critical Care Medicine on 16-18th April, 2026.
