British Deputy High Commissioner Visits SIUT

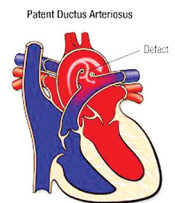

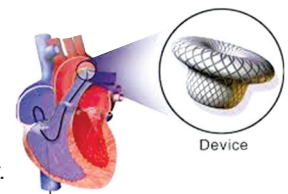

After a review of history, clinical examination, and echocardiogram, she was diagnosed with patent arterial duct (PDA), a congenital persistent communication between two great arteries of the heart, i.e., aorta and pulmonary artery, and requires closure by minimally invasive interventional technique.

The procedure lasted almost two hours, and the defect was successfully closed by interventional cardiac catheterization technique using a plug device to close the communication. The procedure was performed by Dr. Babar S. Hasan and Dr. Nadeem Aslam with support from Dr. Shazia Mohsin, Dr. Mohammad Faiq (Radiology) & team, Dr. Fakhir Raza (ICU) & team, Dr. Qamar (Anaesthesia) & team, Mr. Imran (OR) & team and Mr. Harrison Samuel. The patient remained stable throughout the procedure and was discharged the next day. Special thanks are due to the leadership of SIUT for their commitment to establishing new services. Other departments of SIUT, like radiology, ICU, pharmacy, and nursing services, also deserve special appreciation for their wholehearted support for multidisciplinary care. ■

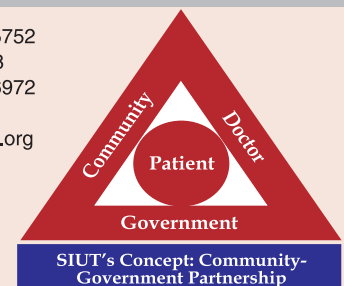

SIUT Participated in CPSP International Medical Education Conference 2023

The College of Physicians and Surgeons Pakistan and The Colleges of Medicines of South Africa organized an International Medical Education Conference focusing the theme “A Paradigm Shift in Postgraduate Medical Education”. A Pre-Conference Workshop on the Principles of Teaching Robotic Surgery was held on 4th of January, 2023 at SIUT, where participants as a part of a group activity had an opportunity for hands-on experience in Robotic Surgery. The highlights of workshop were: Simulation Based Training, Robotic Surgery Training Assessment and Simulation Training Demo.

The second workshop titled, “Creating a Disruptive, Innovative Learning Environment”, was held on January 7th 2023 at SIUT to highlight the role of artificial intelligence (AI), data science, big data and virtual reality (VR) as an evolving and an essential need of medical education.

Dr Babar Hasan, Professor and Chair, Division of Cardiothoracic Sciences at SIUT opened the workshop by describing the objectives of the workshop. He highlighted four objectives i.e. the changing spectrum in health care delivery.

Dr Ibrahim Habib, AKU alumni, spoke about the current demands in health care delivery and the skills needed to tackle these needs.

Dr Muhammad Khurram, gave a brief introduction about AI and the various forms of machine learning tools. Dr. Tariq Mahmood, gleaned from his experiences from various project with leading hospitals in Pakistan highlighted the need of a collaborative approach between physicians and data scientists.

Adil Malik spoke about his main research interests which includes the design and integration of artificial intelligence based non-invasive continuous monitoring medical devices. Adil showed a device the size of a coin that his group is using to detect brain waves,

electrocardiogram and other vital signs. He also demonstrated how these internet of things (IoTs) are being used to deliver efficient and timely care to patients.

Every year World Cancer day is held on 5th February. It is very apt to pay a tribute to The Department of Medical Oncology at the Sindh Institute of Urology and Transplantation providing treatment for several types of cancers at the Hanifa Suleiman Dawood Oncology Center.

Our team of expert physicians and nurses are dedicated to delivering effective treatments for all urologic malignancies including Kidney, urinary bladder, prostate, testicular and adrenal gland tumors. We also treat limited number of breast cancer patients and some cancers of the gastrointestinal tract which includes cancers of the stomach, esophagus and colorectal. As SIUT has a large population of kidney transplant patients, we regularly diagnose and treat post-transplant lymphoproliferative disorders and solid tumors. Patients at SIUT cancer hospital are offered surgery for these cancers as well as chemotherapy and radiation therapy. Our team in oncology includes Surgeons (genito-urinary cancer surgeons, breast cancer surgeons, gastrointestinal cancer surgeons, medical oncologists and radiation oncologist. ■

Symposium on "Medical Retina Imaging and Diagnostics"

The Department of Ophthalmology SIUT, in collaboration with The Ophthalmologic Society of Pakistan (OSP), conducted a 2-day symposium on February 11 and 12, 2023, at SIUT. The symposium focused on "Medical Retina Imaging and Diagnostics."

Eye-related complications in systemic diseases that affect our entire body, like diabetes, are well-known. However, ophthalmic (eye) involvement at SIUT is unique. The patients presenting with them usually have multiple problems like hypertension, diabetes, and cancer. In addition, they may be hemodialysis or immunosuppressant drugs and develop diseases rarely seen in other patients. Technological advancement has helped ophthalmologists make the correct diagnosis and help patients efficiently. Our symposium focused on using advanced ophthalmologic equipment to precisely interpret the reports and help improve patient care using state-of-the-art devices. Dr. Tariq Aziz, the keynote speaker representing the Medical Retina Association of Pakistan, highlighted the importance of ophthalmology and the burden of eye diseases worldwide, especially in a setup like ours. Dr. Mazhar ul Hasan OSP General Secretary speaking briefly, welcomed the efforts of SIUT in developing ophthalmologic services for dialysis and

transplant patients and assured the support of OPS in SIUT efforts.

Dr. Aman Kirmani, from Royal Surrey County Hospital, UK, discussed the basics of Optical Coherence Tomography (OCT). Then Dr. Tarique Saleem from Civil Hospital Karachi and Dr. Mariam Shamim from LRBT, Karachi, spoke in detail about Ultrasound, Fundus Autofluorescence, and macular lasers. Next, Dr. Fatema Ali Lanewala from SIUT talked about the details of Fundus Fluorescein Angiography. Prof. Akhtar Jamal Khan, head of department of Ophthalmology at SIUT followed this and presented his lifelong experience and efforts to introduce modern ophthalmology in Pakistan. Finally, Dr. Rehman Siddiqui from Aga Khan University Karachi, explained the basics of OCT-Angiography, its interpretation, and its clinical application.

We are grateful to the OSP for supporting us in organizing this event and making it a success. ■

Center of Excellence of Robotic Surgery at SIUT has planned a series of webinars on different aspects of robotic surgery. The first webinar in the series was held on February 17, 2023, at SIUT.

The focus of this webinar was to look at robotic surgery from the perspective of Operation Theater technologists. The target audiences were medical technologists, technicians, scrub nurses, and BS Medical Technology students.

Ms. Mehwish Hanif, a Senior Medical Technologist and academic coordinator of the BS Medical Technology Operation Theater Sciences program, moderated the proceedings. National and international speakers discussed the role of medical technologists in robotic surgery. The program started with Mr. Arsalan Afaq, a trained and certified robotic technologist at SIUT, sharing his experience managing robots in Operation Theater. Next, Mr. Andre Joao Palacios DeSilva, a registered nurse at American Hospital Dubai, discussed his experience with CMR from training to the present. He was followed by Ms. Tirsia Sawang, a registered nurse also at American Hospital Dubai, who explained the role of scrub nurse presently in robotic surgery, and how it may develop in the future. Next, Ms. Yusra Hussain, a Certified Robotic Technologist, described the role of

technologists in robotic urological surgeries. She was followed by Ms. Sara Elayah Ahmed, a technical skill trainer from CMR Surgical Dubai, who discussed the training pathways for technicians.

The last speaker of this series was Mr. Junaid Khan, a trained and certified robotic technologist at SIUT. He shared his experience of problems faced as a technologist with solutions for GI Robotic surgery.

This webinar was highly appreciated by the surgical technologists' community, who showed great enthusiasm for learning the latest robotic technology. ■

Research has shown that around 6.7% of hospitalized patients have a severe Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR) with a fatality rate of 0.32%.

On March 11, 2023, the Pharmacy Department conducted a session on ADR reporting by Pharmacists Nida Iqbal and Quratulain. Dr. Muhammad Amir, Manager of Pharmacy Services, supervised the session. The objective of holding this session was to give the nursing staff an updated overview of the importance of ADR and the established mechanism to report an ADR to the pharmacy service. Around 162 nursing staff members attended the session. Attendees showed enthusiasm by asking questions, sharing their experiences, and giving suggestions. ■

Prof Paul Barach's Visit to SIUT

Professor Paul Barach, B.Med.Sci, MD, MPH delivered a talk on **PUBLIC HEALTH QAULTY IMPROVEMENT: A JOURNEY TO A LEARNING CULTURE OF QAULTY** at SIUT on 13th March 2023.

Dr Barach briefed about the Global health quality and presented patient safety status over the past 20 years. His three key note messages were as follows:

1. The Mindset and the will to bring the change in health institute is needed.
2. Systematic approach for improvement of quality is required.
3. Lack of sustainability in QI transformations could be due

to lack of creating a vision, collaborations, communication empowering the team members, and institutionalizing the approaches.

4. Measuring performances by using data dashboards can be one of the solutions.
5. Normalization of deviance need to be addressed and discouraged. Measures like failing to do time out, risk mitigation before procedures, shutting off alarms and breaches of infection control are examples of deviance from standards. ■

World TB Day observed at Kathore

Tuberculosis (TB) is one of the biggest health problems of the developing countries with a significant population being affected by this infectious and debilitating disease. TB is highly epidemic in Pakistan. According to the latest WHO estimations, the incidence, prevalence and mortality of TB in Pakistan are 230 per 100,000, 310 per 100,000 and 39 per 100,000, respectively. This indicates 410,000 incident cases of TB and 69,000 TB deaths in Pakistan every year.

International World TB Day was observed throughout the world including Sindh Institute of Urology & Transplantation Pakistan (SIUT) Kathore.

The program was organized by SIUT for the community with free medical checkups & consultations, dietary advices, distribution of educational literature on TB, exhibition of informative posters/banners and interactive sessions between SIUT medical staff members with the patiente.
