2020: The Year of COVID-19 Pandemic

he year 2020 with be remembered as the year of COVID-19 Pandemic. December of 2019, the first case of coronavirus (SAR-COV2) was reported in Wuhan City, China and subsequently World Health Organization (WHO) designated this as COVID-19 and declared a global pandemic.

The First case of COVID-19 in Pakistan was reported in February 2020. By the

end of 2020 the global number of reported cases was more than 81 million and about 2.0 million died due to COVID-19

infection. The figures for Pakistan by end of 2020 were 0.5 million cases and over 10.000 deaths.

The pandemic changed the world were, wearing of masks, social distancing, hand sanitization and work from home became a norm in most

businesses. The medical profession however remained at the forefront to care for the multitude of people suffering from the virus.

SIUT-maintaining its philosophy of "Free with dignity" established a Corona Virus Clinic and



inpatients facilities in March 2020 to help the general population and its own patient with testing and admission facilities. Over 20,000 patients were screened in the clinic in 2020 and the laboratory performed over 25,000 tests for COVID-19 by PCR where the overall positivity was 23%. More than 6000 patients were treated successfully and 1649 were admitted in ICU and High Dependency Unit (HDU). The overall death rate in admitted patients was 20%, mostly patients with renal failure and on dialysis.



SIUT front line workers bravely worked in the Clinic, ICU and wards however with all the precautions and SOP's 430 staff members got infected and one staff nurse "Ambreen Khalid" unfortunately died of COVID-19. During the pandemic SIUT continued it regular dialysis services with over 1500 dialysis each day and also Transplant OPD and in patient services. Emergency services worked round the clock as usual.

In the initial period general OPD's were curtailed, however by June 2020 OPD's, surgical procedures and renal transplants were started maintaining proper SOP's. By the end of the year 87 Renal Transplants were performed at SIUT. It is hoped that 2021 will see the curtailment of this virus as mass scale vaccination has started globally and Pakistan will also join the rest of the world in this program.


