



facility and treatment to more than 1900 patients.

Later, with the availability of vaccines for people of Pakistan, SIUT was again there to help the people at large. On 18 February 2021, with the help and assistance of provincial government of Sindh, a comfortable air conditioned facility was setup in SIUT.

Following the national guidelines for vaccination provided by the NCOC, frontline health care workers were vaccinated, followed by vaccination of elderly population (60 years and above). Now, all population ages 18 years and above are being vaccinated.

So far till June 30th we have vaccinated 35,775 citizens and health care workers. Vaccines used at SIUT were supplied by provincial EPI center maintaining its cold chain. We at SIUT also ensured that no stone be left unturned in service to the people and their safety. We are administering Sinopharm, SinoVac and CanSino vaccines strictly as per NCOC provided guidelines.

All citizens coming to SIUT for vaccination are issued a token and requested to wait in queue for their turn for NIMS verification. After NIMS verification they are called at counters for demographic data collection. In third step citizen is seen by a doctor who takes a thorough medical history and vitals to ensure the person is fit for vaccination. Upon ensuring the fitness

as per NCOC guidelines the citizen is sent for Vaccination. Trained Nursing staff with team of doctors are there to again ensure safety during vaccination. The citizen is asked to stay seated in the vaccination area for 20-30 minutes for observation of any vaccine related side effects. A team of Doctors is put in place ensure lightning response to any emergency if reported. This is the point from where the citizen is given a clearance to leave the center.

This note will be incomplete without being thankful to all who contributed to make this experience of visit to SIUT as comfortable and satisfying. I would like to thank our Senior leadership who gave us an open hand support to take up this project, Doctors from various clinical departments at SIUT, Nursing and paramedical staff, MSO team, Electronic Health Records (EHR) team, Facility management and Housekeeping departments for their help and contribution to make this a success story.

We are also indebted to all our Donors and well-wisher for their valuable contributions.

Words are not enough to thank you for your strength, courage and dedication. Thank you to everyone working tirelessly on COVID-19 vaccine roll out at SIUT. ■

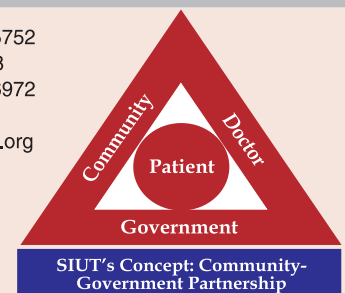

Rabia comes from Kandhkot in Sindh. She is 20 years old and has been educated up to intermediate level. From the age of 17 she began experiencing intermittent bouts of hepatitis, fever and nausea – the reason of which were ignored. Finally, after consultation with a doctor, ultrasound and lab tests, she was diagnosed as suffering from chronic kidney and damaged renal function. Further tests at SIUT's Nephrology Centre revealed her to be in kidney failure, requiring immediate dialysis. Rabia has now been referred to SIUT Karachi, where she is on maintenance dialysis while waiting for a new kidney. Her elder sister is likely to be her donor, subject to further tests.

Tests revealed that her health problems are finally coming to an end and she is looking forward to resuming a normal life after her transplant. In fact, she has been inspired by the dedication of her attending SIUT medical team that she has decided to train to become a registered nurse, so that she too can help people just like SIUT helped her.

Bostan Khan is from district Battagram in KPK. He is 45 years old, married with children. He works as a driver. Although he never sought medical help, he began experiencing some strange symptoms, which continued up to the degree of suffering from fever and back pain, muscle aches and fatigue. During an aggravated episode of these symptoms, he was rushed to a private hospital where he was diagnosed with end stage kidney failure. All of a sudden, both his livelihood and his life hung in the balance.

The wife, daughter, in-laws, including a brother-in-law, were given notice of a "death sentence" and the situation was dire. The wife and daughter were able to get the attention of a community health worker, who was referred to SIUT.

At SIUT, he was given a comprehensive pre-transplant work-up, including screening and tissue matching. A brother turned out to be a suitable match and in 2004 he received a new lease of life when he received his brother's donated kidney.

Ever since, Bostan has been able to lead a normal and healthy life. All he needs to do from now is visit SIUT every four months for his post-operative (PO) check-up where he can get a complete check-up and medical attention. All of it free of cost – the rest of his life will be his own.
