## SIUT Ramazan Campaign



### Hands-on Workshop

IUT hosted a hands-on Cadaver Workshop at its Skill Lab on 14-15 May. The workshop was organized by Dow University, Civil Hospital and Trauma Center in collaboration with the Department of Neurosurgery, Liaquat National Hospital, Pakistan Society of Neurosurgeons, World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies, and International Federation of Neuroendoscopy. The Directors of the course were Dr. Henry Schroeder (Germany) and Dr. Imad Kanaan (Saudi Arabia). Invited faculty included Azam Ahmed (USA), Amjad Shad (UK), Adrian Caceres (Costa Rica), Giovanni Grasso (Italy), Hasan Syed (USA), Joachim Oertel (Germany), Khalid Mehmood (Pakistan), Mahmood Qureshi (Kenya), and Vladimir Benes (Czech Republic).
